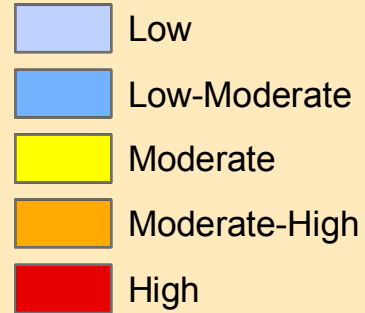


Relative Risks for Forest Health in Idaho
