This sale is located approximately 2 air miles southwest of Coolin on the northern edge of the Jack Pine Flats and on the breaks near the Priest River. A combination of clearcut, shelterwood, seed tree, and group selection methods will be utilized to log the mature stands involved. Tractor skidding, line skidding and harvester/forwarder logging systems will be required. Approximately 0.8 mile of spur road will be reconstructed and 0.8 mile of spur road will be open/improved. Both Class I and Class II streams are present.

Cedar poles and associated sawlogs and cedar products will be harvested on this sale located approximately 7 air miles southeast of Coolin in the North Fork of the East River drainage. Tractor, line and multi-span line skidding will be required. Approximately 0.5 mile of spur road will be constructed, 1.5 miles of spur road will be reconstructed and 5.0 miles of spur road will be opened/improved. Class I and II streams are present.

This sale is located approximately 7 air miles southeast of Coolin. A combination of overstory removal, group selection and clearcut harvest prescriptions will be applied to this mature stand. Both tractor and line skidding will be required. Approximately 0.5 mile of spur road will be constructed, 4.0 miles of spur road will be reconstructed and 3.0 miles of spur road will be opened/improved. Class I and II streams are present.

A combination of seed tree, shelterwood, clearcut, single tree selection and group selection prescriptions will be used to harvest this mature stand located approximately 6 miles south of Coolin. Tractor and line skidding harvest systems will be required. Class I and II streams are present.
