Three members reappointed to Endowment Fund Investment Board

(BOISE) – The Idaho Endowment Fund Investment Board (EFIB) announced today the gubernatorial reappointments of EFIB Chairman Dean Buffington, Representative Neil Anderson, and Senator Chuck Winder to four-year terms on the EFIB.

Mr. Buffington is an investment advisor and a resident of Boise. Representative Anderson is a resident of Blackfoot, a businessman and rancher, who represents District 31A. Senator Winder is a commercial real estate broker, assistant majority leader of the Idaho Senate, and represents the 20th District.

Governor C.L. “Butch” Otter appointed them to the EFIB for a term of four years, ending in 2019. Representative Anderson was first appointed in 2013; Mr. Buffington was first appointed in 2001; and Senator Winder was first appointed in 2009.

The EFIB is an agency of the State of Idaho, headquartered in Boise, responsible for managing more than \$2 billion of investments consisting of state land grant endowment funds, the financial assets of the State Insurance Fund, and endowments for the Department of Environmental Quality, the Department of Fish and Game, and the Department of Parks and Recreation. The EFIB also manages a Credit Enhancement Program for public school bonds. The EFIB is comprised of nine members appointed by the Governor and subject to Senate confirmation.
