
Re CPC Mineral application federal 20-3

I have concerns about issuing this permit. I do not think IDL is giving this the proper attention.

- This site is right in the middle of Bonneville Counties' recreation district. Allowing this would disrupt recreational enjoyment of this area tremendously..
- Winters in this area are long and severe. The area averages three to four feet of snow on the ground each year. Also it is in a hazard flood plain. Both of these increase substantially the chance of a catastrophe involving this well.
- Considering this, the \$50,000 bond is nowhere near adequate.
- This is a somewhat remote area. However it is not out in the middle of a dessert away from other activity. It is in the middle of our little community, in our back yard if you will. The disruption to our peace and enjoyment of our respective properties has been and will be tremendous.
- There are summer homes in this area. The potential for crime increases substantially with the extra activity this activity brings in. What can IDL do to provide the extra protection that will be needed because of this.

All things considered, I ask that this permit be denied.
