Re: Federal 20-3 Well

To Whom It May Concern:

Federal 20-3 Well is located in the southeast portion of Bonneville County. The permit application identifies access to the well location from a public road under the jurisdiction of Bonneville County. The Public Works Department has the following concerns about access to the well site:

1. An approach permit has not been issued for an access at this location. No access onto the road can be constructed until a permit is issued.
2. This department has not been contacted concerning the types of loads on the roads in this area and/or a mitigation plan to reduce damage to the roads.
3. The road providing access to the well site receives summer maintenance only and is closed to all vehicles other than snowmobiles during the winter. County maintenance of the road ends November 15 and the road is usually closed to traffic around December 1 and usually isn't re-opened until mid to late April.
4. The road is a designated snowmobile route in the winter that is regularly maintained by the Bonneville County Parks and Recreation Department. To Date, no proposals to change or move the route have been discussed with the Parks and Recreation Department.

We would appreciate having these issues addressed prior to issuing a permit.
