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Definitions

Drilling Mud- The fluid, water, oil , or gas based , that is used to establish well control, transport cuttings to surface, provides fluid loss control, lubricates the drill string and cools the bottom hole assembly.

Plug Back- To set a plug (usually Permanent) in a wellbore giving a new bottom.

Recompletion- Action that changes the equipment or intake point in a wellbore.

Junk-Debris in a well.

Field- One or more reservoirs grouped by or related to the same general geologic structural feature or stratigraphic condition.

Completion- Instalation in a well of production tubing and equipment, wellhead and tree.
