

Island and Common Area Guidelines

The island and common areas are for the enjoyment of the members, their families and guests when they are with the member. If we all respect the following courtesies, we can all enjoy this great asset together.

- Members are responsible for their own trash. **Pack It In – Pack It Out!!!!** There is no trash pick-up for the common area or the island.
- **We have no life guard!!** Supervise your children!!
- Beach toys and equipment should not be left on the beach. They can be stored behind the lattice areas.
- Due to the possibility of a fire, all fires must be made and controlled in the fire pits or barbecues. Douse the fire with water when you are done or if you leave the area of the fire.
- Motorized vehicles are not allowed on the island except for heavy maintenance and handicap transporting.
- Overnight camping is not allowed.
- Overnight parking is only allowed when the member is out on the lake for an overnight cruise.
- No trailers, boats or others are allowed to be parked overnight. During the day, trailers should be parked in the southwest corner of the common area.
- Kayaks and canoes should be stored in the kayak area only.
- All docks and slips are private and can not be used without the owner's permission. If permission is granted to people staying in Sourdough, the dock committee or a Board member must be notified.
- The boat launch is for members only. Please help control the launch.
- Boats are not allowed in the swimming areas.
- The tennis court is for tennis and basketball.
- Dogs are welcome, but must be kept on a leash for the safety and comfort of others. The owner is responsible to clean up after their dog. Bags are available by the launch area.
- A reservation is needed for any group of family/guests numbering 12 or more for a gathering. Contact the island committee or a Board member to save a date at least a week ahead to be sure another group has not reserved it. The area that can be reserved is the far east beach area, commonly called the "power boat beach". Reservations will not be granted for major holidays or the weekend of the annual meeting when we normally have a picnic for all members.

To help keep our island, common area, boat slips and launch areas private, please talk to your neighbors and if you find out that the people you are talking to do not belong, please ask them to leave right away. Our area is private and should not be used by the public.
