



From the IDL homepage on the right side under **Additional Resources click** on **GIS**, **Maps**, **Land Records**.

You will be taken to the Maps & Land Records page.



Click on Digital Land Records Database Viewer.




Hover over the right side of the **Map** page, the **Layers** menu will appear.

In the **Layers** menu you may select the activities you are seeking, such as Residence for Cottage Site leases, Oil and Gas for those leases, etc. You should always ensure the **Map Annotation** function is selected.


If you know the legal description for the detail you want, enter into the Township, Range, and Section boxes at the top of the screen.

If you do NOT know the legal description, please take the following steps:




Click on the **Zoom In** icon. You can then select the area you want to identify by clicking on that area of the map, and dragging your mouse to draw a box out around the area you would like detail of. You can continue this process of *zoom in* until you have the precise area you want.


**→** The **Pan** icon allows you to move around in the map.



To access IDL history of a specific parcel, select the **Identify** button then click on the parcel.



When you have identified an area, the **Identify Results** menu will appear on the right. Clicking on the blue information in the **Township/Section** will bring up the IDL history of the parcel and any related documents IDL may have (example below).
