RE: APPLICATION ERL95S1378B – North Idaho Maritime / John Condon. Building a commercial dock and a commercial work area on Lake Coeur d'Alene in Wolf Lodge Bay.

Dear Idaho Department of Lands,

There are many reasons not to approve the permit for any commercial dock in Wolf Lodge Bay. Several of my colleagues and I were discussing the proposal and were appalled that it would even be considered, given the public degradation it would cause.

Wolf Lodge Bay is a beautiful natural habitat that you see first as you come into the Coeur d'Alene area from the east on I-90, and Highway 97 is a national scenic byway. The proposed dock would obliterate the area as far as aesthetic beauty in an economy dependent on tourism.

The natural habitat for eagles and so many aquatic animals, including spawning, would be disturbed and cause negative effects for them. Each year students from the Coeur d'Alene School District attend field trips on the cruise boats of the CDA Resort to learn about the eagles and the habitat in the Wolf Lodge Bay. It would be appalling to have this sort of a dock in the midst of the bay and have it affect the wildlife there.

Please do not approve the permit, for the sake of the economy, our area wildlife, and the future citizens of our Coeur d'Alene area. Thank you for your work in representing all of us, the public.
