My wife Joy and I are both strongly opposed to the NIM application for use of Wolf Lodge Bay for commercial activities related to dock construction and maintenance. Wolf Lodge Bay is a popular fishing and recreational area and my understanding is that it is a spawning area for Kokanee as well. Extending a pier into the bay and loading and unloading barges with equipment will be disruptive to this area - not to mention being a blight on the pristine beauty of the area along the scenic byway. Approving the applicant for his desired use of the bay will also bring about unsafe conditions for people that travel along HWY 97. The property location is right at a sharp blind curve and trucks pulling out of the site onto the hwy will GUARANTEED be the cause of numerous accidents in the future.
