I am writing in vehement opposition to John Condon/North Idaho Maritime's plan to build and develop a commercial dock and commercial work area on Lake Coeur d'Alene in the Wolf Lodge Bay.

With the proposed size of the dock and the planned anticipation of attached work barges in this location, as well as tow boats coming and going, this commercial business will essentially block Wolf Lodge Bay off from safe and healthy use by anyone else who wants to boat, fish, kayak, paddleboard, or enjoy the scenery and wildlife that now are in this Bay. Fish and wildlife of all kinds will definitely be impacted in a negative way.

This proposal clearly goes against the IDL's mission statement to protect public trust values in order to allow an individual commercial business to benefit at the public's cost. That Bay belongs to ALL of us, and no commercial business has the right to destroy it for the general public's use and enjoyment.
