Compensation

Total compensation is the complete compensation package for benefitted employees, factoring in both the employee's annual salary, and what the state contributes for their benefits.

If a benefitted, seasonal employee makes \$15 per hours and works 1,385 hours (average hours worked in 8 months), their total compensation may look like this:
