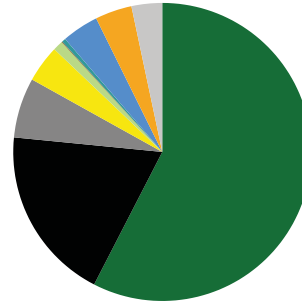

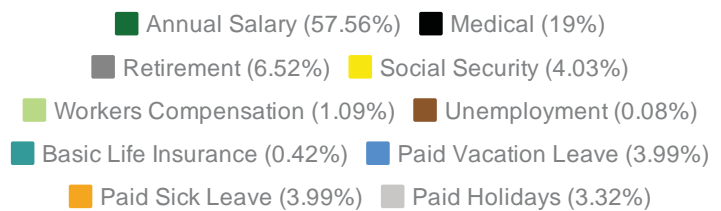
Compensation

Total compensation is the complete compensation package for benefitted employees, factoring in both the employee's annual salary, and what the state contributes for their benefits.

If a benefitted, seasonal employee makes \$15 per hour and works 1,385 hours (average hours worked in 8 months), their total compensation may look like this:



$$\begin{aligned}
 & \$20,775 = \text{Annual Salary} \\
 + & \$15,316 = \text{State of Idaho Contributions} \\
 \hline
 & \$36,091 = \text{Total Compensation}
 \end{aligned}$$
