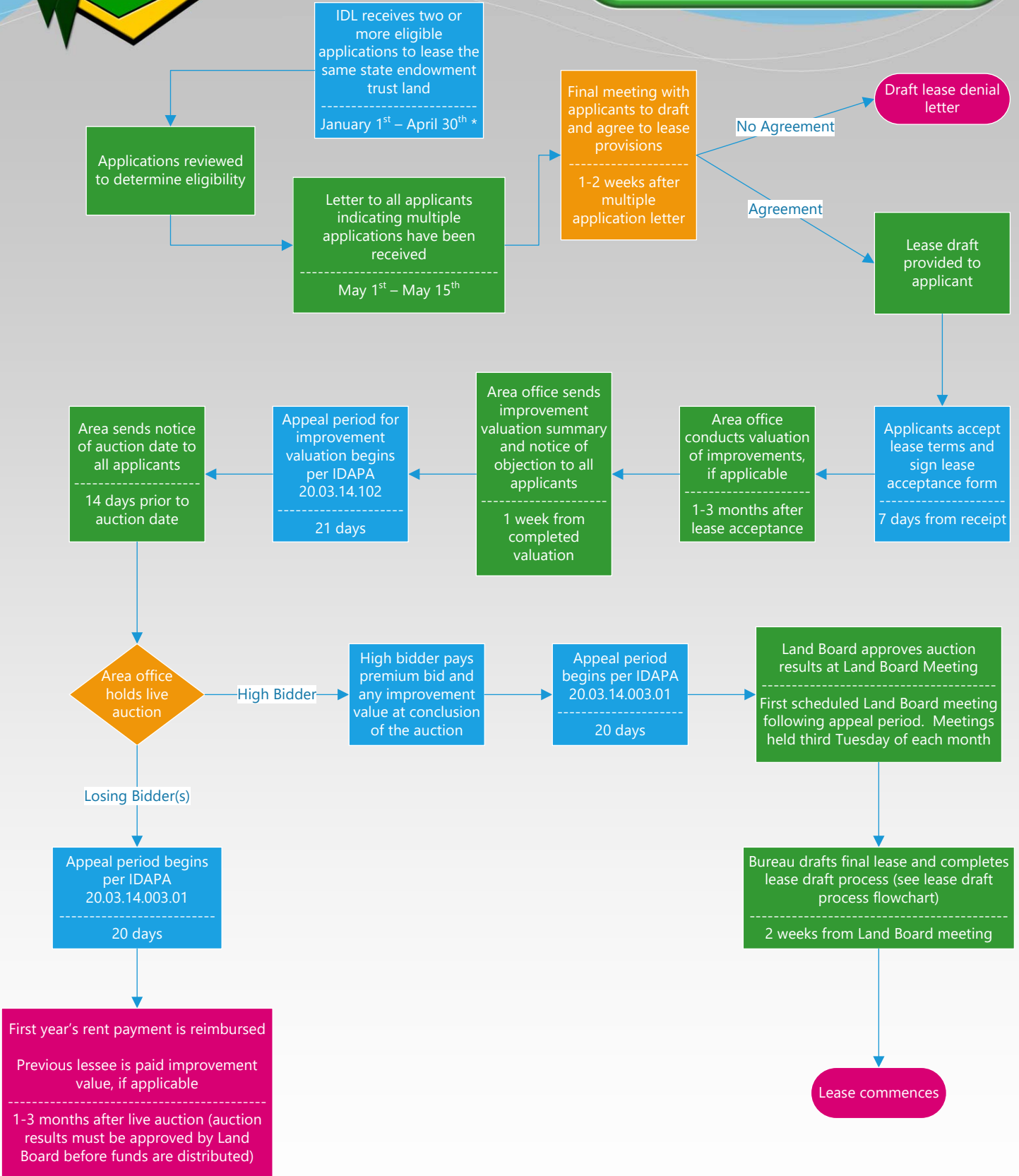
Purpose
