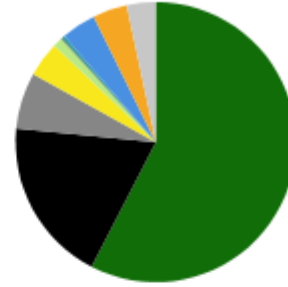

Compensation

Total compensation is the complete compensation package for benefitted employees, factoring in both the employee's annual salary, and what the state contributes for their benefits.

If a benefitted, seasonal employee makes \$15 per hour and works 1,385 hours (average hours worked in 8 months), their total compensation may look like this:



\$20,775 = Annual Salary
 + \$15,316 = State of Idaho Contributions

 \$36,091 = Total Compensation

- Annual Salary (57.56%) ■ Medical (19%)
- Retirement (6.52%) ■ Social Security (4.03%)
- Workers Compensation (1.09%) ■ Unemployment (0.08%)
- Basic Life Insurance (0.42%) ■ Paid Vacation Leave (3.99%)
- Paid Sick Leave (3.99%) ■ Paid Holidays (3.32%)
