#### **SCOPE OF WORK**

#### PROJECT NAME: REPLACE FURNACE WITH PROPANE FURNACE AT PRIEST LAKE

LOCATION: Priest Lake Residence 1, "Trevor House", 5303 Dickensheet Rd., Coolin, ID 83821

CONTRACTING OFFICER REPRESENTATIVE: David Thornton

#### PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Priest Lake, Idaho Residence 1, referred to as the Trevor House, requires replacement of the existing heating system with a Propane Furnace with a minimum capacity of 84,000 BTUH.

#### PROJECT REQUIREMENTS FOR PROPANE FURNACE REPLACEMENT:

- 1. Contractor will ensure they meet any and all State trade licensing requirements. All work to be completed will meet all applicable State and Federal laws.
- 2. Contractor and or sub-contractors will furnish all materials, labor and equipment necessary for work described below.
- 3. Contractor will remove and replace existing furnace with a Propane Furnace with minimum efficiency rating of 84,000 BTUH.
  - a. Contractor will furnish and install new propane furnace.
  - b. Contractor will coordinate the installation of a 250 gallon propane tank.
  - c. Contractor will ensure that furnace is installed securely and install supports if necessary.
  - d. Contractor will be required to replace wiring and/or ducting as needed.
  - e. Contractor will ensure propane plumbing fixtures are connected and operational.
  - f. Contractor will ensure electrical work associated with this project is operational.
  - g. Approximate size of heated area is 2,200 sq ft. Contractor is responsible for verifying the accuracy of all measurements. This is a residence and the temperature needs to maintain comfortable living temperature.
- 4. Work Coordination: All work performed must be coordinated through the designated Idaho Department of Lands Contracting Officer Representative. Work shall occur over the course of one weekend unless other arrangements are approved by the Area Manager.
- 5. Contractor shall be responsible for all permits and permit fees.
- 6. Contractor is responsible for all cleanup at the site and disposal of garbage, including old unit and associated materials.
- 7. The Contractor shall remove any materials not utilized in the work upon completion of the job, resulting in the premises being left in a clean and tidy condition.

#### **SAFETY:**

Contractor shall comply with all applicable local, state, and federal safety regulations including:

- Federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Standards.
- The Contractor will be solely responsible for safety at the site.
