I. Registering as a Remote Bidder

All persons, <u>including Lessees</u>¹, wishing to bid remotely must be approved by Auctioneer as a qualified remote bidder and shall complete the following **No later than four (4) calendar days** prior to the Auction:

- 1. Register for an account with the online auction platform Proxibid (<u>www.proxibid.com</u>) and provide Auctioneer with Proxibid username.
- 2. Complete and deliver the Remote Bidder Registration Form, Auction Terms and Conditions, Escrow Instructions for Holding Bid Deposits², and other necessary auction documents (all of which will be available for review on Auctioneer's website www.corbetbottles.com) to Auctioneer at emily@markbottles.com
- 3. Deposit with Escrow Agent (Attn: Tami DeJournett, First American Title Company) the Bid Deposit, fees, and other required deposits to be paid by a Successful Bidder on Auction day as set forth in the Auction Terms and Conditions.³

Upon review and acceptance of the above-mentioned documents and deposits, Auctioneer will send the Remote Bidder notice that they are eligible to participate remotely in the Auction and grant the necessary permissions on Proxibid to enable them to participate as a remote bidder.

II. Remote Bidding Disclaimer

- Auctioneer's internet service may not function properly the day of the Auction.
