Zero-Based Regulation

Ensure Idaho regulations remain streamlined, user-friendly, and easy to understand.

Changes to Draft Rule Text (1 of 2)

Reduction to Overall Word Count

- ~~20.03.03.001.01. **Title.** These rules are titled IDAPA 20.03.03 “Rules Governing Administration of the Reclamation Fund,” IDAPA 20, Title 03, Chapter 03~~

Changes to Draft Rule Text (2 of 2)

Late Fee Description Section 026

03. Annual Payments Non-Refundable. Payments to the Reclamation Fund will be billed annually and are non-refundable. ~~Payments will be billed annually and, if not timely paid, will accrue late fees and interest as established by the Board. New participants will be assessed a pro-rated payment based on the Department's established billing cycle.~~

04. Late Payments. Payments not received by the due date are considered late and will result in the following monthly charges:

a. A late charge of \$25.00 or 1% of the unpaid principal obligation, whichever is greater.

b. An interest charge of 1% on the unpaid principal obligation.

- September 6 Proposed rule published in Bulletin and start of 21-day public comment period
- September 27 Deadline to submit comments to the Bulletin
- October 17 Present pending rule to Land Board
- 2024 Present pending rule to 2024 Legislature
