Changes to Draft Rule Text (1 of 2) Reduction to Overall Word Count

 20.03.03.001.01. Title. These rules are titled IDAPA 20.03.03 "Rules Governing Administration of the Reclamation Fund," IDAPA 20, Title 03, Chapter 03

Changes to Draft Rule Text (2 of 2) Late Fee Description Section 026

03. Annual Payments Non-Refundable. Payments to the Reclamation Fund will be billed annually and are non-refundable. Payments will be billed annually and, if not timely paid, will accrue late fees and interest as established by the Board. New participants will be assessed a pro-rated payment based on the Department's established billing cycle.

04. Late Payments. Payments not received by the due date are considered late and will result in the following monthly charges:

a. A late charge of \$25.00 or 1% of the unpaid principal obligation, whichever is greater.

b. An interest charge of 1% on the unpaid principal obligation.
