The person engaged in cutting of forest products agrees to provide for the management and reduction of fire hazard in accordance with the following option:

- OPTION 1 No Hazard Created: The Contractor attests that he or site will not curan amount of timber sufficient to cause a fire hazard. Purchaser(s) need not withhold slash management monies but are required to report all products purchased to the Idaho Department of Lands (IDL). If later inspection shows that a fire hazard has been created, the Contractor will be required to post a cash bond of not less than the current minimum slash withholding rate for each forest product harvested and will also be required to manage said fire hazard as prescribed by and within the time limit set by IDL. All subsequent cutting under this agreement will be administered in accordance with bond withholding requirements of IDL.
- OPTION 2 Bond Withholding: The Contractor elects to treat the fire hazard created and to subsequently receive a refund of slash monies withheld. The Contractor will supply a cash bond to IDL by having the purchaser(s) withhold the specified dollars per thousand board feet or equivalent, if forest products other than sawlogs are delivered to the purchaser(s). Purchaser(s) shall withhold specified slash management monies and shall report and remit such withholding to IDL. This remittance becomes a cash bond held by IDL. The Contractor will manage the fire hazard created to the specifications in the Rules Pertaining to the Idaho Forestry Act and Fire Hazard Reduction Laws, IDAPA 20.04.02.000 *et seq.* (the "Slash Rules") on or before the expiration date of this agreement (or extension).

Upon completion of the fire hazard management work, the Contractor will notify IDL in writing whereupon IDL may inspect for satisfactory completion. IDL will make payment of the withheld monies, less six percent to the Fire Suppression/Forest Practice accounts, and issue a Certificate of Clearance. If the Contractor fails to manage the fire hazard, all bond monies will be forfeited. The Contractor will be liable for the cost of suppression after the expiration date of this agreement, if the work is not completed, as specified in Idaho Code §38-122.

OPTION 3 Surety Bond: The Contractor agrees to operate under the terms of a surety bond, currently in force, which provides for management of fire hazards on the land above described. Purchaser(s) need not withhold slash management monies but are required to report all forest products purchased to IDL. The surety bond provided by the Contractor to IDL is in an amount sufficient to equal the current minimum cash bond for all forest products to be harvested. The Contractor will pay six percent of the current minimum bond rate to the Fire Suppression/Forest Practice accounts for all forest products harvested. The Contractor will manage the fire hazard created to the specifications in IDAPA 20.04.02.000 *et seq.* (the "Slash Rules") on or before the expiration date of this agreement (or extension).

Upon completion of the fire hazard management work, the Contractor will notify IDL in writing whereupon IDL may inspect for satisfactory completion and issue a Certificate of Clearance. If the Contractor fails to manage the fire hazard, IDL will make demand upon the bond for the costs of managing the fire hazard. The Contractor will be liable for the costs of the suppression after the expiration date of this agreement, if the work is not completed as specified in Idaho Code §38-122.

- OPTION 4 Contract: The Contractor has entered into a contract with IDL for management of the fire hazard in accordance with Idaho Code, §38-404. Purchaser(s) shall withhold slash management monies at the rate indicated on this agreement for all forest products delivered to the purchaser(s) and shall report and remit such withholding to IDL. Once the Contractor has paid the full amount of monies for the contract area, IDL will issue a Certificate of Clearance. IDL will manage the fire hazard to the specifications of IDAPA 20.04.02.000 *et seq.* (the "Slash Rules").
- OPTION 5 State-Owned Property: IDL will be the Certificate Holder. Purchaser(s) need not withhold slash monies but are required to report all products purchased to IDL. IDL will manage the fire hazard to the specifications of IDAPA 20.04.02.000 *et seq.* (the "Slash Rules).

All Options: Purchaser(s) will report volume and/or remit monies as indicated for the particular option on or before the end of the month for the preceding month's purchases. The slash withholding rate shall be the minimum rate in force at the time the products are delivered to the Purchaser unless otherwise indicated as follows: \$______ per _____.
