- ◆ \$590,000 total funds available for 2024/2025 funding year
- ◆ Accepting proposals for Urban and Community Forestry projects located in disadvantaged communities, identified using the Climate and Economic Justice Screening Tool ([CEJST](#))
- ◆ Eligible Applicants include: City, County, Tribes and Non-profit 501c3 organizations
- ◆ Project types include but are not limited to: Tree Inventory updates, Risk Management, Tree Pruning & Removal, Tree Planting & Replacement, Workforce Development, Education & Training
