I understand you have been holding townhall meetings regarding the negotiated rulemaking. I would like to add my comments:

- IDL should adopt rules specific to Bear Lake, since its fluctuating water levels distinguish it from the other large recreational lakes.
- IDL should clarify that the one guaranteed moorage for littoral owners is not a limitation on moorages for commercial operations/marinas with lots of beachfront.
- The rules should more expressly contemplate your jet ski moorage system and/or contain a "catch-all" set of standards that applies to things that don't fit neatly within the categories of encroachments in the rules.
- The rules should define the term "encroachment" and/or identify items and activities that do not qualify as encroachments.
