Creating home sites, a marina, and other facilities in a unique ecosystem like that at Trestle Creek endangers wildlife and degrades human life. Depriving Bull Trout and Kokanee of their spawning grounds (which this project cannot help but do) is ecologically unsound. The eagles, beaver, and other animals that populate this area will be drastically impacted. This area is one of the only places that we can bring our children to see spawning bull trout and kokanee salmon. Depriving our local population of direct experiences with nature degrades the kind of life most of us here in North Idaho cherish and work to protect.

Additionally (and not inconsequentially) the plan to remove part of an existing island, reform the main shoreline and parts of the peninsula will require the excavation of 12,500 cubic yards across 3.2 acres. Replacing these excavated portions of natural shore would be 3, 830 feet of hardscape. The damage this project will cause has immediate as well as long-term negative impacts on the lakeshore around it. That cannot be denied.

And where will the select humans who can afford to rent marina slips relieve themselves? There's no plan for restrooms. And where will the boats with wastewater storage dump that waste? There's no plan for that either.

Trestle Creek is the primary spawning location on Lake Pend Oreille for bull trout, a threatened species. Loss of this spawning ground could permanently endanger bull trout populations in LPO.

Hardening nearly a mile of natural shoreline impacts critical habitat for fry and fingerling of all fish species, as well as birds and mammals like muskrat, beavers, mink, deer and moose.

The construction of seven luxury homes and the accompanying lawns will degrade water quality by introducing excess nutrients and encouraging algae growth. This is already a problem along the lakeshore.

Many people who recreate on Lake Pend Oreille and its tributaries are sportspeople. The development of Trestle Creek is not in the interest of any angler or hunter. Conversely, it's only in the interest of the Idaho Club to develop its marina.
