Rebuttal to Rivelle Closing Statement on encroachment permit application L95S6105A, regarding weeds on page 18 – "The proposed dredging will allow larger vessels to travel around the commercial work dock without disturbing the bottom of the lake and preventing any weeds from being caught and pulled up from the bottom of the lake." That statement completely misses the point of our complaint. We never said that the weeds were coming from the area to be dredged. The problem occurs because to get to that dock they are coming in from the east on a navigational route they show on their plan, circling around the end of their L shaped dock and dragging weeds from the shallow waters in front of the Sailboat Club and properties 100 feet or more to the west.

These weeds will collect in our swimming area and pile up on our beaches. They have an agreement with Hagadone Corp. that they will not park vessels on the east side of their dock so they will have to come in using that navigation route.

I am going to send a rough drawing of the area showing the shallow weedy waters in the area of the Sailboat Club and properties west of them.
