3. This permit does not convey the State's title to or jurisdiction or management of lands lying below the natural or ordinary high water mark.
4. Acceptance of this permit constitutes permission by the Permittee for representatives of the Department of Lands to come upon Permittee's lands at all reasonable times to inspect the encroachment authorized by this permit.
 The Permittee assumes all liability for damages which may result from the exercise of this permit.
 This permit does not relieve the Permittee from obtaining additional local or Federal permits as required.
7. This permit is not valid until the number assigned is displayed in letters not less than three inches in size upon the dock or piling.
8. The construction of the above-listed encroachment is authorized for a period of thre years. From the <u>27th</u> day of <u>August</u> , 19 <u>86</u> , to the <u>27th</u> day of <u>August</u> , 19 <u>89</u> Applicant may apply for an extension if the project is not completed in the specific time period.

SPECIAL TERMS:

- 1. This permit is issued subject to the established commercial navigational servitude. The permittee places this encroachment at his own peril and specifically waives any claim against commercial log tow operators who may accidentally damage this encroachment.
- Treated wood may not be used where it will be in contact with the water (i.e., piling and float logs).
- 3. Panhandle Health District I has specified that no plumbing may be included in the boat service building.
- 4. All materials (i.e., paint, paint chips, solvent, chemicals, petroleum products, etc.) used in the boat service must be contained so they do not enter the Spokane River.
- 5. There is a recognized need for a commercial boat service for large-sized vessels on Lake Coeur d'Alene. No such facility is presently available. The encroachment distance into the river is acceptable when compared to existing encroachment by the DAW mill just upstream from this site.
- 6. This permit is not valid until the permittee executes sovereign land lease with the Idaho Department of Lands, pays for 1986 occupancy, and submits a \$1,000 performance bond.

THIS LEASE AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 1st day of January , 1987, between the STATE OF IDAHO, by and through the State Board of Land Commissioners, as Lessor, and Fred Finney, W. 600 Hubbard Coeur d'Alene, ID 83814, as Lessee.

WITNESSETH

SECTION 1. LEASED PREMISES: In consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements of the parties hereto, the Lessor does hereby lease and demise to the Lessee the following described state-owned real property situated in Kootenai County, State of Idaho, to-wit:

A tract in Govt. Lot 4, Section 8, Township 50 North, Range 4 West, B.M., and more particularly described as follows:

Adjacent to the easterly 100 feet of Tax No. 4232, being an area over the bed of the Spokane River and adjacent to lands owned by the Lessee within the area shown on encroachment permit number L-95-S-3071 and the attached approved marina boatweigh site plan, containing less than one acre General Fund lands.

SECTION 2. TERM: This Lease shall continue in force an in effect for a term of ten (10) years, commencing on the 1st day of January, 1987, and terminating on the 31st day of December, 1997.

SECTION 3. RENTAL: The Lessee agrees to pay a minimum annual rental of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00) annually, or ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) per acre, or fraction thereof, per year, in advance, and rental for the year 1986 shall be computed from the 1st day of January, 1986, and payable in the amount of \$250.00. Commencing on January 1, 1987, the Lessee agrees to pay \$100.00 per acre, or fraction thereof, per year, in advance, on or before the 1st day of January of each year, or a minimum of \$250.00 annually, whichever is greater, for each calendar year thereafter.

It is expressly agreed that the rental is subject to such modification as may be established by the State Land Board as a result of its Interim Committee Study now pending, and that the final policy as established by the State Land Board in respect to Marina lease fees, which subjects this Lease to modification in conformity with such policy as shall be established. Rentals to be paid after such policy is established shall be prospective and not retroactive in application.

SECTION 4. REVIEW OF RENTAL AND LEASE TERMS: The Lessor has the right to raise and lower the annual rent to be paid by Lessee, as of the beginning of any calendar year hereunder, by providing Lessee with six (6) months prior written notification of the same and to negotiate conditions of lease as deemed necessary.

SECTION 5. USE OF PREMISES: Lessee agrees to use the leased premises for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining a breakwater, walkway, floating docks, and marina facility as described in Encroachment Permit No. L-95-S-3071, issued by the State or as amended by due process and incorporated herein by reference for the use of Fred Finney, and his heirs and assigns, and Lessee further agrees that he will not commit, permit, nor suffer commission of any damage to or waste upon the leased premises, nor permit any unlawful use of the leased premises, nor permit any use thereof except as stated above or otherwise provided in this lease.

SECTION 6. USE BY THE STATE AND OTHER PARTIES:

- A. The Lessee agrees that the State of Idaho, Department of Lands, shall be entitled to have access at no cost to the boat harbor and any dock therein in policing the waters of the Spokane River within this leasehold or in the protection of life and property on or adjacent to the Spokane River and further than, in case of any marine emergency, any person in distress of life or health may have access at no cost to said harbor and docks to obtain safe haven and prevent injury or loss of life.
- B. The Lessee agrees that general public shall have access to boatweigh services subject to reasonable fees. Fees for services shall be comparable to fees charged at similar private boatweighs.

SECTION 7. CONSTRUCTION AND IMPROVEMENT: All construction on and improvement of the lease site must be approved in writing by the Stand Land Department Director or his authorized representative prior to starting construction or improvement. All construction on and improvement of the lease site must comply with all those rules and regulations of the State Board of Land Commissioners, or permits authorized thereby, and those rules and regulations of any other government agency of competent jurisdiction. The Lessee must furnish a complete set of construction plans and an accurate plot of all improvements contemplated under this section. Improvements are all structures or works in or on the bed or waters of the Spokane River.

SECTION 8. SEWAGE AND GARBAGE DISPOSAL: The Lessee shall at all times keep the premises in a clean and sanitary condition. Sewage disposal will be considered the responsibility of the Lessee, subject to supervision by the Department of Health and Welfare and the Department of Lands. Garbage and household solid wastes shall be disposed of by the Lessee in a manner designated by the State and/or County.

SECTION 9. SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL: The Lessee agrees to comply with the State laws to keep the site free from hazards and to maintain the area in a condition acceptable to public health and safety standards as promulgated by the State Department of Health and Welfare.

SECTION 10. FIRE AND SAFETY REGULATIONS: The Lessee agrees to comply with the State laws to keep the site free from hazards and to maintain the area in a condition acceptable to public health and safety standards as promulgated by the State Department of Health and Welfare.

SECTION 11. RESERVATIONS: The Lessee expressly reserves the following additional rights:

- A. All mineral rights, easements, and rights-of-way, the fee title to the leased premises, and title to all appurtenances and improvements placed thereon by the Lessor.
- B. To grant easement over the leased premises, providing said easements do not conflict with the facilities being maintained and operated by the Lessee upon the leased premises.
- C. To require changes in sanitation or recreational facilities to be made in the interest of the public health and safety or the preservation of property.
- D. To issue leases for exploration and development of oil, gas, geothermal, and mineral resources, so long as such leases do not interfere with uses authorized under this lease.
- E. To enter upon and inspect the leased premises and any buildings or structures situated thereon at any reasonable time.
- F. To re-enter and take possession of the leased premises, with or without process of law, upon breach of any term or condition hereof, and thereupon cancel this lease agreement.
- G. To reserve any and all water from any source on State land as its sole property and to hold water rights for any beneficial use developed as a result of this lease.

SECTION 12. RELATION OF THE PARTIES: It is understood and agreed that the Lessee shall in nowise be considered an agent of the Lessor in the construction, operation, or maintenance of any of the facilities situated upon the leased premises. Lessee shall not permit nor suffer any lien, judgment, nor encumbrance against the demised premises and covenants to satisfy any such lien, judgment, or encumbrance at his sole and separate expense.

SECTION 13. REVERSION OF LEASE AND IMPROVEMENTS: Upon expiration with no application to renew or upon termination of this lease for cause or upon request of the Lessee, the Lessee shall surrender to the Lessor said land and shall remove improvements constructed thereon including the breakwater and any dock or landing pier which may be erected within the boundaries of the above-described tract of land without compensation for any portion thereof on depreciated basis or otherwise.

SECTION 14. ASSIGNMENT, SUBLEASE, TRANSFER: The Lessee shall not assign this lease nor sublet in whole or in part without the prior approval of the State Board of Land Commissioners.

'SECTION 15. INSURANCE INDEMNITY: The Lessee covenants to render the State of Idaho whole from any damages or claim arising from Lessee's use and occupancy of the demised premises, and such covenant shall in nowise be limited by the amount of insurance coverage provided herein.

SECTION 16. BOND: The Lessee will furnish a cash or surety bond in the amount of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) in favor of the State of Idaho to protect the State against loss due to violation of any clause of this lease, as required by Section 58-309, Idaho Code. Said bond will be kept in force for one year beyond the expiration date of the lease and must be furnished prior to start of any development.

SECTION 17. LAWS APPLICABLE: All applicable laws of the State of Idaho are incorporated herein by reference, except as lawfully varied by the contractual terms of this agreement.

SECTION 18. COVENANT: It is mutually understood and agreed by the parties hereto that all of the terms, covenants, conditions, and obligations in this lease contained are of the essence and shall be binding upon the heirs, executors and assigns of the Lessee.

SECTION 19. RESPONSIBILITY: The Lessee agrees to assume all responsibility for damages done to property not subject to the lease and for all injuries sustained by himself or his employees as a result of faulty equipment or negligence of the Lessee. It is understood and agreed that the Lessee shall, in no way, be considered an agent of the State in any manner whatsoever and shall save harmless the State of Idaho, its officers, agents, and employees from any and all claims for damages or injuries to persons or property that may be sustained in connection with this lease.

SECTION 20. CIVIL RIGHTS: The Lessee pledges to conform with existing laws, rules and regulations concerning civil rights, equal employment, and minimum wages.

SECTION 21. LICENSE: The Lessee hereby certifies that he is licensed to do business in the State of Idaho.

SECTION 22. CANCELLATION: The site development must be completed by September 1, 1989. If not, this lease may be cancelled by the State Board of Land Commissioners. The Commissioners may also forfeit or cancel this lease upon thirty (30) days written notice to the Lessee should they fail to comply with any of the covenants, terms, or conditions of this lease. If during the term of this lease agreement or any extension thereof, the Lessor, acting by and under this authority, shall determine that the public interest requires termination of the lease, the Lessor shall have the right thereupon to purchase the improvements placed upon the leased premises by the Lessee, to remove them, or to require the Lessee to remove them, at the option of the Lessor.

This lease is contingent upon the Lessee holding a valid encroachment permit. Failure to maintain such an encroachment permit shall result in Lease cancellation.

STATE OF IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF LANDS ATTACHMENT FOR ENCROACHMENT

Required When Applying for an Idaho Dept. of Lands Lake Encroachment Permit

"Joint COE-IDL Applications" for encroachment must be signed by the riparian or littoral property owner or his lessee. A riparian or littoral owner is the person whose upland property interfaces the ordinary or average highwater mark of a given waterway. A complete application must include the legal description of the upland property; a vicinity map showing the location of the proposal; design plans showing the adjacent boundary lines, encroachment dimensions, water depth, and a lakebed profile, all relative to the ordinary or artificial high water mark; and name and address of the adjacent property owner(s).

DOCK REQUIREMENTS AND SET BACKS

General requirements are as follows:

- 1) Encroachment installed perpendicular to the general shoreline.
- 2) Encroachment not to extend beyond a depth necessary for customary navigation nor beyond the established line of navigation.
- 3) Dock encroachment is not to exceed 700 square feet in size nor 10 feet in width, excluding a slip cutout.
- 4) Approach ramp is not to exceed 6 feet in width. ONLY 4 PILINGS ALLOWED.
- 5) Structure may not be closer than 10 feet to adjacent property and/or riparian boundary lines without written consent from the adjacent property owner, as riparian lines extend into the water perpendicular from the general shoreline.
- 6) Commercial encroachments are required to maintain 25 feet from adjacent property and/or riparian boundary lines.

CONSENT OF ADJACENT RIPARIAN OR LITTORAL PROPERTY OWNERS

Navigational and nonnavigational encroachments located adjacent to an upland property may infringe upon the adjacent property owner. Signature of the owner(s) will automatically rebut this presumption. The owner's signature below and initials per applicant's drawing will complete the permit requirement process.

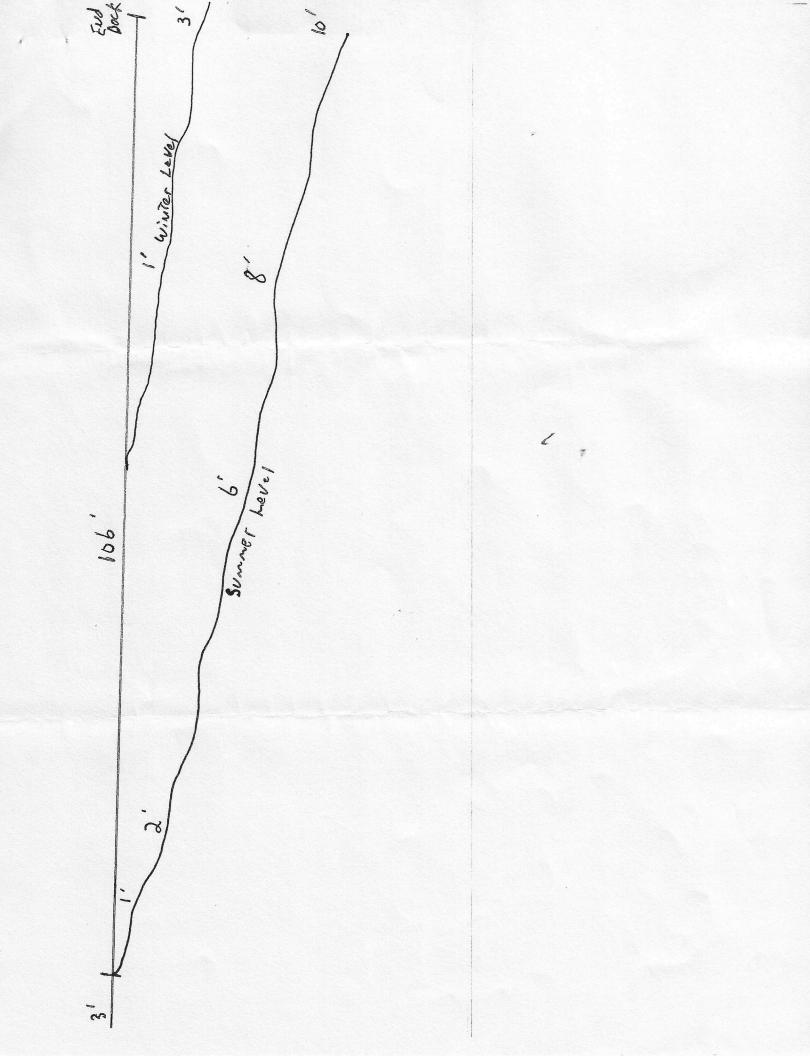

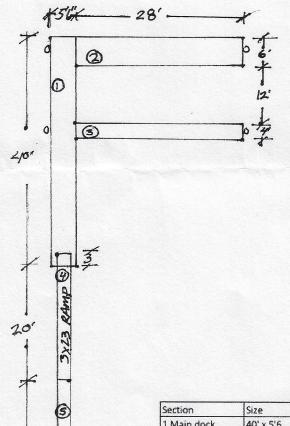
