To request remote public testimony, you must submit a written request to the Office of Administrative Hearings at filings@oah.idaho.gov at least seven calendar days prior to the hearing along with an explanation as to why your testimony cannot be provided in-person on the date of the scheduled hearing.

3. **A prehearing conference will be held via Zoom on February 26, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. Mountain Time.** A Zoom link for that conference will be sent contemporaneously with this order. The purpose of this conference is to discuss all prehearing matters, including objections, stipulations, narrowing of issues, burden of proof, and any other preliminary matters that need to be addressed prior to the hearing.

4. To “file” and “serve” their documents, the parties may email them to all other parties at the addresses listed in the attached Certificate of Service before any deadline, with a copy to leslie.hayes@oah.idaho.gov and filings@oah.idaho.gov.

5. The Hearing Officer may arrange for a court reporter. The cost of the court reporter appearance fee will be borne by IDL. If transcripts are ordered, the cost of the transcript will be determined pursuant to IDAPA 62.01.01.601.

6. Should any party or counsel require special accommodations pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act, they must notify the Hearing Officer of such request by **February 13, 2026**.

NOTICE AND REMINDER: The Hearing Officer shall not be contacted by any party ex parte. All email communications with the Hearing Officer should be copied to all other parties. If necessary, the Hearing Officer will make himself available for conference calls set up by the parties upon notice, should there be any particular procedural questions that need to be addressed prior to
