- \$200,000 total funds available for 2026 -2027 funding year
- Accepting proposals for Urban and Community Forestry projects located in disadvantaged communities, identified using the [USDA Poverty Area Measures](https://www.ers.usda.gov/data-products/poverty-area-measures) (<https://www.ers.usda.gov/data-products/poverty-area-measures>)
- Eligible Applicants include: City, County, Tribes, Non-profit 501c3 organizations, and public & state-controlled educational institutions
- Project types include but are not limited to: Tree Inventory Updates, Risk Management, Tree Pruning & Removal, Tree Planting & Replacement, Workforce Development, Education & Training
