#### Definitions:

- Class 1 Stream are important for the spawning, rearing or migration of fish
- Class 2 Stream are usually headwater streams or minor drainages that are used by only few, if any, fish for spawning or rearing
- SPZ - Stream Protection Zone - means the area encompassed by a slope distance of 75 feet (Class 1) or 30 feet (Class 2) on each side of the ordinary high-water marks
- Perennial Stream - is defined as a surface water that flows continuously year-round
